The Region of South Gippsland offers an enviable amount of attractions, eateries and accommodation. We will base our activity on the regions centre of Wonthaggi.

Come along and visit the engineering details of the San Remo Bridge, check out the Kilcunda Trestle Bridge, review the State Coal mine precinct

At just over an hour's drive south-east of Melbourne, the Bass Coast offers over 180 kilometres of spectacular coastline, beautiful wilderness areas, scenic hinterland and a relaxed life style.







Victoria has a rich engineering heritage and this is your chance to see some of it, feel it and learn a bit about it!

This free, guided coach tour on the Saturday will take you to some of South Gippsland's engineering landmarks: the **Phillip Island Bridge**, the **Kilcunda Bridge** and remnants of the **State Coal Mine**:

- The Phillip Island Bridge (San Remo to Newhaven) connects the mainland with Phillip Island. Constructed to replace a 1940 suspension bridge, the reinforced concrete, cantilever bridge opened in 1969. A FoxCam operates on this bridge.
- The **Kilcunda Bridge** is a 91m timber trestle over Bourne Creek that was constructed for the Victorian Railways to carry coal from the Powlett Coal Fields from 1911 until 1978.
- Wonthaggi's **State Coal Mine** opened in 1910 to supply coal for Victoria's railways. At its peak the mine produced 2,474t/day with Victorian Railways buying 90% of production.

Led by Matthew Churchward as our guide, this tour shines a light on the legacy left by Victoria's engineering pioneers!

NOTE: The whole weekend is premised, that all participants do so at their own risk.
